

A Genealogical Profile of Thomas Higgins

Birth: Thomas Higgins' date and place of birth are unknown.

Death: His date and place of death are unknown.

Ship: unknown, before January 1633/4

Life in England: Nothing is known of his life in England.

Life in New England: There is only one reference to Thomas Higgins in Plymouth Colony court records. In the court held on January 1, 1633/4, "having lived an extravagant life," Thomas Higgins was placed with John Jenny as an apprentice for eight years. At the end of that time, Jenny was to provide him with double apparel [two suits of clothing], 12 bushels of corn and 20 acres of land. Nothing further is known.

Family: There is no evidence that Thomas Higgins married or had children.
